





ALL APPRENTICES NEED TO SCHEDULE THEIR CLASS BEFORE JULY 25TH - SCAN THE QR CODE

What is needed, when registered through an approved apprenticeship, to apply for an exam through the State Plumbing Board:

- Indentured Apprentice: The applicant must be currently enrolled in an approved apprenticeship program through the Louisiana Workforce Commission and registered as an apprentice through the State Plumbing Board
- Tradesman: have performed 3.000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-iob
- supervision of a journeyman or master plumber licensed by the board.

  Journeyman: have performed 7,000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-job
- supervision of a journeyman or master plumber licensed by the board.
- Natural Gas Fitter: performed 3,000 hours of manual labor of plumbing under the direct, constant, on-the-job supervision of a journeyman or master natural gas fitter licensed by the board.
